Andrew Hess, PhD retired in 2014 from his position as a pediatric psychologist at Sunnyview Rehabilitation Hospital in Schenectady, NY, where he also served as a Chairman of the Department of Psychology for 17 years. He is currently an adjunct Assistant Professor in the Department of Neurology at Albany Medical College and is also in private practice. He conducts neuropsychological evaluations and treats inpatient and outpatient children and adolescents with traumatic brain injuries and other brain disorders. Dr. Hess has over 30 years of experience in providing clinical and administrative services for traumatic brain injury programs and to the patients at Sunnyview Hospital.
